### New Competition Framework Event Bands

Senior events will be split into bands against competitors of similar ranking index. The aim will be for no less than 4 and no more than 8 per band, but racing against an appropriate ranking will take priority. The winner of each band will receive medals.

- Run from the clubhouses under British Rowing Rules and the British Rowing Rules of Racing will apply.
- Masters crews with no opposition and where an event cannot be formed through a handicap, will be moved to Senior into a band of appropriate ranking index unless they specify otherwise.
- Juniors of J15 and above without opposition and unable to move up will be moved to Senior into a band of appropriate ranking index.
- Crews that cannot move up may row as time only for half the entry fee, crews with opposition will take priority. Time only crews will NOT receive medals.
- The draw will be held at 21.00 on Monday 9<sup>th</sup> October at the address mentioned below.
- Entry fees are £10 per seat. Payment on day will incur a £2 additional charge per seat.
- Entries taken on BROE2. Payment to be taken on BROE2 or via cheque to Kenny Holmes, Burton Head, 7 Tunicliffe Court, Swadlincote, DE11 8JT. Cheques made payable to 'The Burton Head'.
- Please note that as river conditions can vary we reserve the right to change the length of the course, race upstream or withdraw certain boat categories for safety reasons if necessary.
