

BURTON LEANDER & TRENT ROWING CLUBS

The Burton Head Spectator information

Burton Leander and Trent Rowing clubs are both located on Stapenhill road, Burton on Trent. Roadside parking is available alongside Stapenhill gardens, Alternative parking is available at Newton Road recreational ground and chargeable car parking at Meadowside Leisure center.

Toilets and refreshments are available at both clubs. Trailer parking will be allocated prior to the event to make best use of the available space. Road Marshals, wearing Hi-viz will be available at the clubs to assist with road safety.

First aid facilities are available at both clubs, at the finish and additional first aid boxes are in the safety launches.

The start for the 3.5k race is adjacent to the Riverside Hotel which is readily accessible as a view point.

The start for the 2k race is on a public footpath alongside Branston Golf club, accessible via the footpath from the washlands. Care must be taken to observe from behind the golf tee area.

The finish is 80m upstream from the ferry bridge accessible via walking from the clubs, through Stapenhill gardens, the public car park at the Hollows, close to the church, a small car park adjacent to Jerrams Lane, or by accessing the washlands via Watson Street (near Tesco).

The event takes place in a public open space and there is no control over photography. However please do not take and publish photos which include non family members, without the permission of the appropriate adult.

Please do not use drones unless you have asked for and given permission from the organising committee.

The results will be published as soon as possible after the finish of the second division. Shortly afterwards presentations will be made for event winners and pennants awarded for the fastest open and fastest women's crews.
