Framework Event Bands

Senior events will be split into bands against competitors of similar ranking index. The aim will be for no less than 4 and no more than 8 per band, but racing against an appropriate ranking will take priority. The winner of each band will receive medals.

Beginner Events offered over 2k course in Senior for crews with 0 Ranking points

1. The event will be run from the clubhouses in compliance with the [British Rowing Rules of Racing](#).
2. Masters crews with no opposition and where an event cannot be formed through a handicap, will be moved to Senior into a band of appropriate ranking index unless they specify otherwise.
3. Beginner crews with no opposition will be moved to Senior if an appropriate ranking opposition is available.
4. Juniors of J15 and above without opposition and unable to move up will be moved to Senior into a band of appropriate ranking index.
5. Crews that cannot move up may row for time only for half the entry fee, crews with opposition will take priority. Time only crews will NOT receive medals.
6. The draw will be held at 20.00 on Monday 27 September at Burton Leander Rowing Club, DE15 9AE
7. Entry fees are £10 per seat. Payment on day will incur a £2 additional charge per seat.
8. Entries and payment on BROE or cash on the day. No cheques accepted.
9. Please note that as river conditions can vary we reserve the right to change the length of the course, race upstream or withdraw certain boat categories for safety reasons if necessary.
